Wise woman builds her house With own hands, foolish one tears down 2 He whose walk is upright fears Yah He whose ways are devious despises him 3 Fool's talk brings rod to his back Lips of wise protect them 4 Where no oxen, manger is empty From strength of ox, abundant harvest 5 False witness pours out lies Truthful witness does not deceive 6 Knowledge comes easily to discerning Mocker seeks wisdom, finds none 7 Stay away from a foolish man, you will not find knowledge on his lips Wisdom of prudent is to give thought Folly of fools is deception to their ways Fools mock at making amends for sin Good will is found among upright 10 Each heart knows its own bitterness, and no one else can share its joy 11 House of wicked will be destroyed Tent of upright will flourish 12 There is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to death. 13 Even in laughter, heart may ache and joy may end in grief 14 Faithless will be fully repaid Good man rewarded for his ways 15 Simple man believes anything Prudent man gives thought to his steps 16 Wise man fears Yahweh and shuns evil Fool is hotheaded and reckless 17 Quick-tempered man does foolish things and a crafty man is hated. 18 Simple inherit folly Prudent crowned with knowledge 19 Evil men will bow down in presence of the good, and wicked at the gates of the righteous 20 Poor shunned even by their neighbors Rich have many friends 21 He who despises his neighbor sins Blessed is he who is kind to the needy 22 22 Those who plot evil go astray Those who plan good find love and faithfulness 23 All hard work brings a profit Mere talk leads only to poverty 24 Wealth of the wise is their crown Folly of fools yields folly 25 Truthful witness saves lives False witness is deceitful 26 He who fears Yahweh has a secure fortress, for his children it will be a refuge 27 Fear of Yahweh is a fountain of life, turning a man from snares of death 28 Large population is a king's glory, but without subjects a prince is ruined 29 Patient man has great understanding Quick-tempered man displays folly 30 Heart at peace gives life to the body Envy rots the bones 31 He who oppresses poor shows contempt Whoever is kind to needy honors Elohim for their Maker 32 When calamity comes, the wicked are Even in death, the righteous have a refuge brought down 33 Wisdom reposes in heart of discerning Even among fools, she lets herself be known 34 Righteousness exalts a nation Sin is a disgrace to any people
